## Construction History Society of America announces a new Call for Abstracts and rescheduled 7th Biennial Meeting on Construction History at Kennesaw State University; June 2-4, 2020

We invite researchers and practitioners from all aspects of the history of construction to submit presentation abstracts on subjects relating to the Americas for the 7th Biennial Meeting on Construction History, to be held at Kennesaw State University (airport: Atlanta).

Hosted by the Construction History Society of America and Kennesaw State University, this Biennial follows successful meetings held in College Park, MD (2018), Austin, TX (2016), Minneapolis MN (2014), Cambridge MA (2012), Philadelphia PA (2010), and Atlanta GA (2008).

Kennesaw State University and the College of Architecture and Construction Management are delighted to host the next CHSA conference in June 2022 on our historic Mid-Century campus in Marietta, GA. Founded in 1832, Marietta is the county seat and has a rich history of its own, but we will highlight the marble industry in North Georgia and the 19th century quarry owners who amassed huge fortunes here. We plan to visit one of the oldest still operating marble quarries for a back-of-the-house tour, and the grand home of one marble magnate which showcases the quality and diversity of the stone to be found nearby.

### Abstracts for Presentation

Abstracts for presentation imply that the author(s) intent is to present the subject within a 20-minute slideshow. CHSA encourages authors to also submit full papers to *Construction History* according to their publication schedules. The acceptance of an abstract for the CHSA Meeting does not exempt papers from the Journal's review process.

Each abstract must include authors' names, contact information, institutional affiliations, an abstract of 4000 characters (maximum), key words (selected, if possible, from the list of topics and subjects), and a one-page curriculum vitae indicating titles and publications or other relevant work for each author. All presentations must be in English and related to Construction in North and South America.
